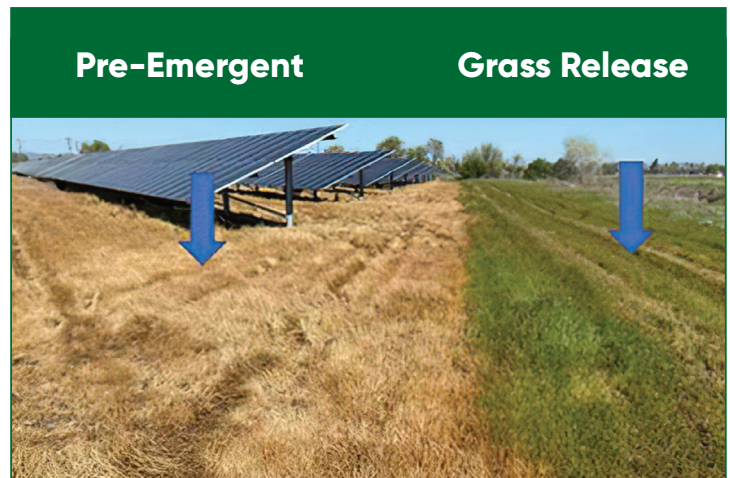
TerraVue® CA herbicide introduces a new active in Rinskor®, the latest member of the arylpicolinate family of chemistry. This is a unique and new class of synthetic auxin chemistry within the Herbicide Resistance Action Committee's Group 0 (WSSA Group 4) category. TerraVue, the new cornerstone for post-emergent resistance management and broadleaf residual weed control, may be applied alone or in a tank-mix combination with 64 oz Cleantraxx® herbicide to non-cropland areas if the desire is total vegetation control.

The flexible label allows for applications of 2.85 – 5.7 oz/acre for total vegetation control. This will allow customers to dial-in the rate needed based on weed population or length of control desired. This flexibility is a strong upgrade over Milestone® Herbicide alone and will offer broader knockdown power with Rinskor active. Applicators in railroad crossings, railroad beds, roadsides, and non-crop rights of way that require removal of total vegetation will benefit greatly from this ability to use higher rates giving them longer residual.

For total vegetation control, apply TerraVue® CA herbicide at 2.85 to 5.7 oz per application.

Restrictions

- Do not broadcast apply more than 5.7 oz per acre of TerraVue per year.
- Do not treat inside banks or bottoms of irrigation ditches.
- Do not apply TerraVue within the root zone of sensitive trees unless injury can be tolerated. Use special caution near roses, mulberry, redwood, Chinese elm, and leguminous trees such as locusts, redbud, mimosa, and caragana.
- Do not hay or graze if use rate is above 2.85 oz per acre.
- Do not apply under the dripline of desirable trees or immediately adjacent to susceptible broadleaf crops.





Other Key Points to Consider with TerraVue® CA herbicide:

- TerraVue® CA herbicide can be used to control terrestrial weeds that extend up to the water's edge.
- Over 120 broadleaf weeds and brush species are controlled by TerraVue CA. *See label for species controlled, timing, and rates.*
- Labelled for non-crop areas, for example: airports, barrow ditches, communication transmission lines, electric power and utility rights-of-way, fencerows, gravel pits, industrial sites, military sites, mining and drilling areas, oil and gas pads, non-irrigation ditch banks, parking lots, petroleum tank farms, pipelines, roadsides, railroads, storage areas, dry storm water retention areas, and substations.
- TerraVue CA is an important tool in the fuel management of our forests. As the devastating fires in recent years have shown, the effective management of trees and brush can help in a total management program.
